 - 6) Vehicles are permitted in camping area for loading and unloading ONLY!

 - 7) Camping groups MUST sign in at the coffee house when you arrive. Please donate the suggested amount for your stay. More will gratefully be accepted, Approved scholarships are available.
 - 8) Any changes to grounds or buildings are to be done with prior board approval.
 - 9) No amplified noise after 8pm, quiet time after 10pm unless board approved events.

 Please respect our 10pm quiet time. We need to be friendly neighbors and would like our neighbors to be our friends as well.
 - 10) If staying more than 4 nights please contact a board member for permission(special rates available.)
 - 11) Each LRRC member has an obligation to see that our rules are complied with. All members are the campground caretakers when you are here.
 - 12) Pick up all trash and leave your campsite clean for the next members.
